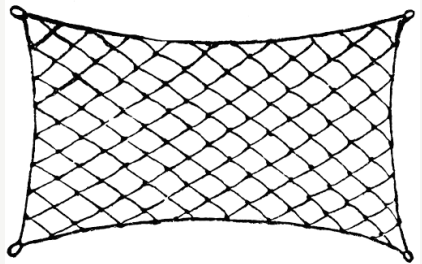
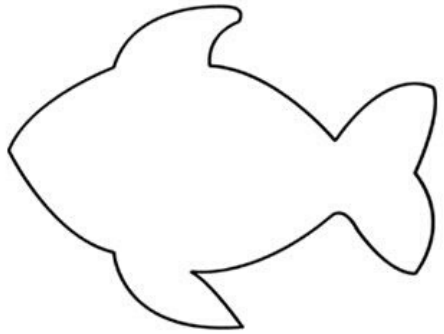
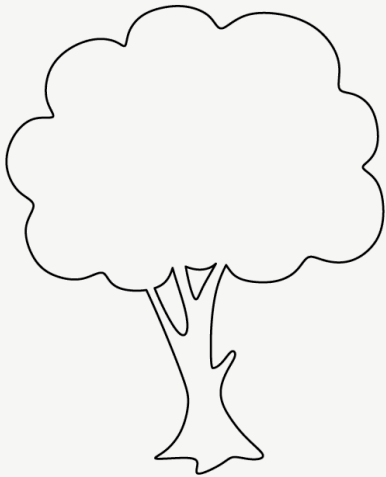

What was good about each of these things? (If you're unsure, ideas can be found at the bottom of the next page!).



Have a go at retelling the story with your cut-outs. God's Spirit is like a river of fresh drinking water bringing life.

In Ezekiel's vision the salty water became fresh. Have a drink of water from the tap then add some salt to it.
